Reports to: School & Sport Camp Coordinator, Summer Camp Team Leader and Sport Services Manager, Talisman Center

Responsibilities:

Customer Experience

- Communicate all pertinent information (program changes, child behavior concerns, accidents and injuries) to the parents and/or guardians of the participant in a positive and professional manner
- Communicate and collaborate with coworkers to provide an engaging and well-organized program.

Evaluation

- Provide constructive feedback and recommendations to the Summer Camp Team Leader to assist with improvement of camps.

Leadership

- Be a positive role model for participants.
- Supervise participants throughout all parts of the program including during lunch and on field trips to ensure their safety.
- Be an active participant in the pools during swim time while ensuring the safety of participants.
- Ensure that camp participants are disciplined in a positive, proactive and appropriate manner which does not hinder safety or self-esteem in any way. Inform the Summer Camp Team Leader of any behavioral situations as they arise.
- Respond to emergency situations utilizing training and Talisman Centre Policies and Procedures.
- Carry first aid kit on your person at all times.
- Carry a camp radio on your person at all times.

Organizing and Planning

- Plan sessions for participants including sport activities, cooperative games, teambuilding and wide games.
- Follow daily camp schedule, using replacement activities of equal value where necessary.
- Set up and take down of equipment.
- Fill out accident/ incident reports when required and follow up when needed.
- Follow up with the Summer Camp Team Leader on any situations that arise.

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- Be aware of any medical conditions within camp groups by reading through the medical packages distributed by the Summer Camp Team Leader.
- Respect and maintain equipment and supplies, and encourage camp participants to do the same. Report losses or damages to the Summer Camp Team Leader.

Training

- Attend Summer Camp Staff Training (2 days in June), 2016.
- Attend in-services, meetings and training as required.

Education:

- Working towards or have completed your degree in Education, Human Kinetics, Kinesiology, Physical Education, Sport Administration or a related field.
- CPR C (recertified within one year) and Standard First Aid (recertified within 3 years) – required before employment can commence.
- NCCP coaching certification Level 1 and/or completion of the Water Polo Canada Community Club Coach training.
- HIGH FIVE® Training is an asset.
- Experience Delivering WPC “I Love Water Polo Program. “
- Completion of Making Ethical Decisions (MED) training

Qualifications:

- 1 year of experience working with children.
- Previous coaching, camp counseling or teaching experience is an asset.
- High energy level with excellent organizational and time management skills and the ability to work in a fast pace environment.
- Proven track record working independently and in a team environment.
