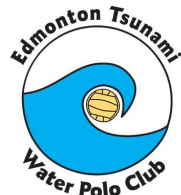

Qualifications:

- Must be a Canadian citizen or permanent resident.
- Experience in water polo and/or swimming coaching and team management. Successful candidates must possess a thorough knowledge of the rules, regulations, strategies, and techniques of water polo.
- NCCP Certificated or working towards certification.
- Must hold or to have completed prior to start date:
 - Respect in Sport Activity Leader Training
 - Making Ethical Decisions Online Evaluation
 - Safe Sport Training
- Must be able to provide a Criminal Record and Vulnerable Sector Check (completed within the past two years).
- Possess a valid driver's license would be an asset.
- University degree(s) or pursuing a diploma in sports management, business, marketing, communications, leadership, or related field considered an asset.



Key Responsibilities:

- Work with the program Head Coach and Lead Coaches to implement a training plan for the 16U and 18U teams.
- Hours can vary based on successful candidates availability, but up to 10 hours of weekly on-deck coaching working directly with Tsunami athletes to develop the technical, tactical and team skills needed to succeed at a national competition level.
- Attend Tsunami tournament/game events. This will include up to 6 NCL weekends each season and potentially one domestic club-wide training trip each year. Again based on the successful candidates availability
